The Library is the cultural, creative, and educational hub of our community, and we are proud to support the thousands of free programs, events, and services that enrich the lives of all Angelenos across the city.

In the past year:

- The 73 library branches were visited 13.5 million times.
- 15,700 free lunches were served to children in the summer.
- 30,430 students used Student Zones resources, including tutoring, college prep workshops, and more.
- 49,525 patrons received computer assistance and training.

program snapshot

The Tenth Annual Toast will support the Library's Future-Ready Teens umbrella of programming, which helps develop problem-solving and critical-thinking skills through tutoring, test prep, interview workshops, technological literacy training, and honing leadership skills with the Democracy Project. This just-launched project provides resources, mentors, and training for teens to be able to implement community projects — building a generation of active, informed, and engaged citizens.
