## service snapshot

The Library is the cultural, creative, and educational hub of our community, and we are proud to support the thousands of free programs, events, and services that enrich the lives of all Angelenos across the city. Throughout the pandemic and beyond, the Library is an essential safety net for so many in our community.

In the past year the Library has provided:

- Over 52,000 hours of free, one-on-one online tutoring for students in over 40 subjects;
- Early-childhood literacy online workshops for over 33,000 viewers;
- Individual tutoring and group classes for over 17,000 adults working on their English literacy skills;
- And much, much more.

## program snapshot

Funds raised by this year's Toast will support the Helping Students Succeed umbrella of services at the Library, which runs the gamut from early literacy programs for new parents, to free online tutoring for students, to college prep workshops, and beyond.
